Chunk of the Month A mystery quilt for 2022

How it works:

- Each month I will show you how to piece a particular block. Some months you will be tasked with making four of those blocks, some months eight.
- I will give yardage requirements and exact measurements but you can decide your own dimensions if you prefer.
- Each month we set aside the blocks we've made.
- By the end of 6 months we will have 44 components to create a 48" square quilt. I will give diagrams of various layouts to choose from. You can create your own and also add sashing if you wish.
- No two quilts will look the same!

You will need:

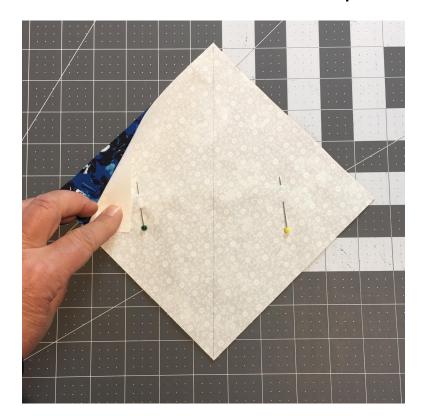
- 2 yds Dark
- 1.5 yds Light
- or scraps!



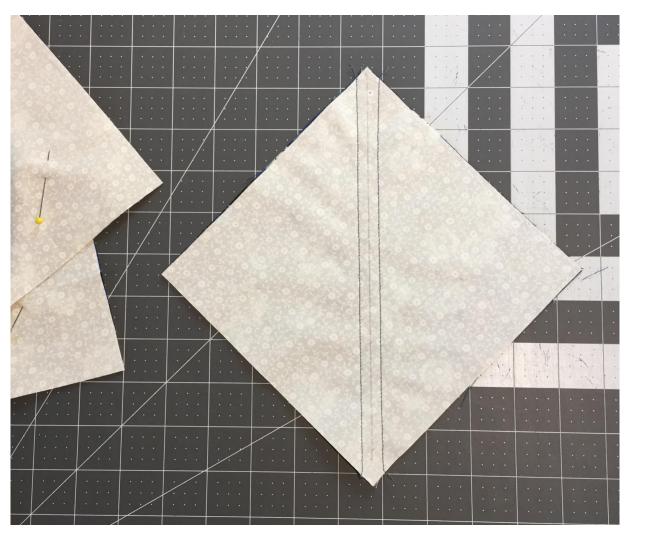
Chunk 1 - to make 4 blocks: Cut eight 6½" squares from light fabric Cut four 6%" squares from both light and dark fabrics



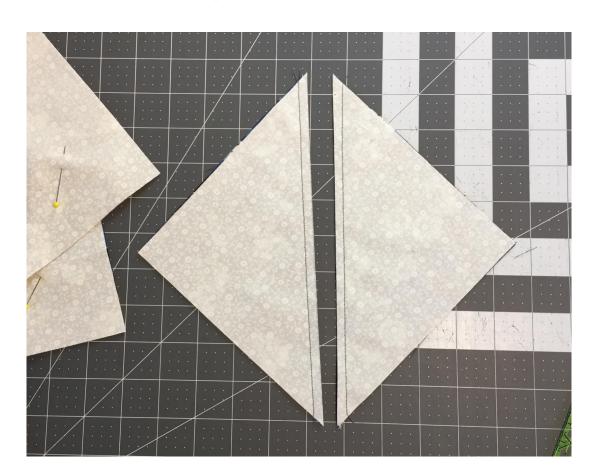
Place one light and one dark 6 %" squares right sides together Draw a line in pencil diagonally across the light square Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " either side of the pencil line







Cut along the pencil line



Press seam allowance towards the dark fabric



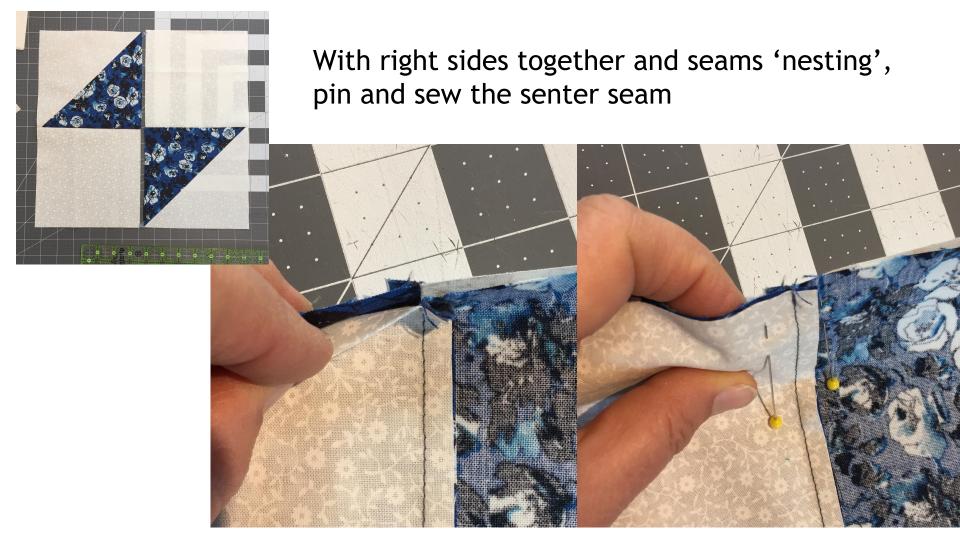


Lay out the half square triangles with the light 6½" squares



Pin and sew top squares to bottom squares, right sides together





I choose to press these seams open





Make four of this block 12½" unfinished



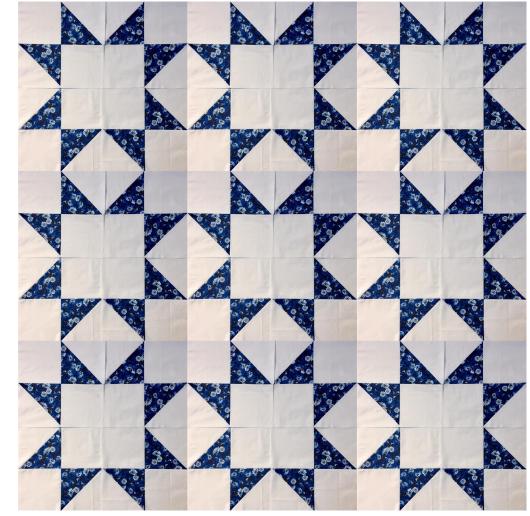
Do not sew these four chunks together! Wait until month 6.

You may decide to put them in the center of your quilt, but they could also be positioned in the corners or have sashing between them.

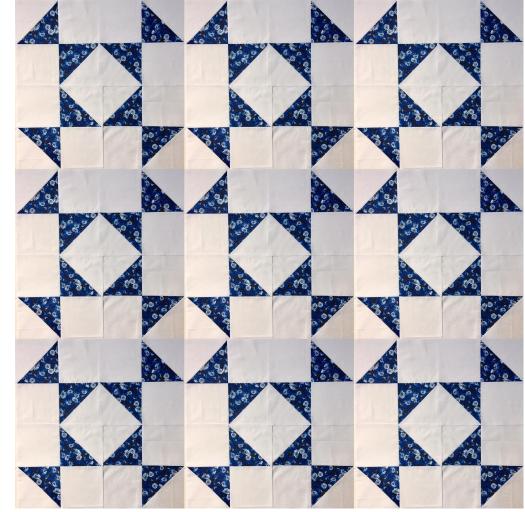
4 blocks - or a quilt of 36 blocks





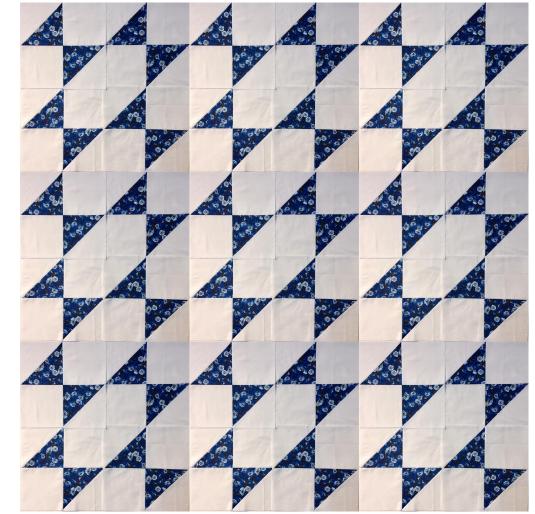
4 blocks - or a quilt of 36 blocks
