- July 27, 1978 Newsletter named The Friendship Knot.
- Oct. 7-8, 1978 "Quilts: An American History" show of over 100 quilts displayed at the Scottish Rite Temple in Oakland; organized by Glendora Hutson, Roberta Horton and Helen Goeriz.
- May 9, 1979 EBHQ hosts Northern California quilt groups, later to form N.C.Q.C. (The Northern California Quilt Council).
- Sept. 28-29, 1979 "A Festival of Quilting Arts" demonstrations and workshops by EBHQ members
