

Accidental Artist Full-Day Workshop

Supply List



When you design quilts as you go, you embrace serendipity and become an “accidental artist”. Learn several methods of creating fused quilt designs in an improvisational manner. Begin with a heap of pre-fused fabric scraps from Laura’s stash to trigger your design ideas. Learn various systems for constructing your artwork and put your colorful fabric kit to good use. You’ll create and learn as you go. It’s fun to design on the fly!

Supplies Participants Should Bring:

- 2 yards of regular weight Wonder-Under fusible web (paper backed #805). Please DO NOT BRING Heat ‘n Bond or Steam a Seam
- 1 yard of parchment paper
- Sharp scissors like small 5” knife blade scissors
- Paper scissors
- Rotary cutters, ruler, and mat
- Specialty blades, like Pinking, Wavy, or Scallop (optional)
- Batting, 1 piece measuring about 18” x 18”
- Quilt backing fabric, 1 piece measuring about 18” x 18”
- Iron and ironing surface (if not provided by group)
- Thimble (optional)
- Small plastic bag for fabric scraps
- Tweezers (optional).

\$25 Kit Fee: Includes hand out, pre-fused scraps, hand-dyed fabrics and threads, and a needle.

A bag of fused fabric scraps from Laura’s stash is available for students to use.
