

Free Motion Cutwork – Table Topper or Scarf

Supply List

- Your best machine for free motion quilting.
- Free Motion or Darning foot for your machine. In general, an open-toed foot is best. You must have a free motion foot for this class.
- Blue wash out marker.
- 2 spools of *quality* thread - you'll want 2 colors that will look great against the fabric you chose. If you feel timid about your free motion quilting, use a thread that blends, if you want the design to stand-out, use a contrasting thread. You may want to put a different color in the bobbin for a versatile look.
- 1 wound bobbin of one of your thread choices.
- Ruler 18-24" long.
- Sharp, short, sturdy scissors for the cutwork (see class handout).
- **Table topper:** 2 different 30" widths of 45" fabric - quality quilting cotton. Fabric must be solid or near solid.
 - Enough 2-sided fusible to fuse your two pieces together. I prefer Misty Fuse but any light weight fusible will work.
- **Scarf:** Two 14" x 72" pieces of the same rayon batik - solid or near solid. Quilting cotton is not suitable. Avoid strong patterns. See note below for shopping suggestions.
 - Enough Misty Fuse to fuse your two pieces together; can use other 2-sided fusibles *if they do not alter the hand of the fabric*. You don't want a stiff scarf!
- Spray fabric stiffener. Terial Magic is great for this but any spray fabric stiffener will work.
- Topstitch needle in an appropriate size for your thread.
- Thread snips.
- Unlined paper for practice. Even better, packing paper or other large sized paper.
- Helpful: Straight stitch throat plate, slider for machine bed.

NOTE: 30 Minutes of homework before class:

- Pre-wash fabric.
- Fuse your two fabrics together, with right sides out and the fusible between.
- Spray with stiffener, let it get damp dry, iron flat.
