

### **CLASS PREPARATION**

In preparation for this class, please bring all the items in the 'Supplies' list and have all your fabrics chosen and numbered. Our goal in the Full Day session is to cut out, piece and attach at least the first 2 vertical rows of the pattern.

Optional: If you are really keen and you know how to use the Hex N More ruler, you can cut out all your pieces ahead of time using the 3 1/2" equilateral triangle, 3 1/2" half hex, and 6 1/2" whole hexagon.

### **QUILT SIZE**

We are using the Hex N More Ruler: 6 1/2" Hexagon, 6 1/2" Half Hex and the 3 1/2" Equilateral triangle.

The overall, pieced hexagon will be 48.5" across and 54.5" from top to bottom.

### **SUPPLIES**

Hex N' More Ruler (alternatively, you can use provided templates),  
6"x24" or 6"x12" quilting ruler  
Rotary cutter or scissors  
cutting mat  
Pencil or marking tool e.g. Frixion pen)  
Small ruler with 1/4" marks  
Straight pins  
Thread  
Masking tape/stickers/paper for labeling blocks.

### **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

The Weight of Love pattern is flexible enough that you can really use any number of fabrics in solids and/or prints. In order to complete the overall hexagon, you will require a total of 5.5 yards of fabric. I suggest a minimum of 6 colours in a range of light, medium and dark solids/prints.

In summary, total fabrics required:  
Hexagonal top: 5.5 Yds (22 fat quarters)  
Background fabric: 3.5 Yds  
Batting: 2 Yds  
Quilt Backing Fabric: 4 Yds
