

Dancing With The Wall Quick Step Supplies:

- Sewing machine and all stuff that goes with sewing: scissors, thread, sharp rotary cutter, cutting mat (as large as you can fit in your car-small ones are hard to work on), pins for pinning pieces together and for putting onto design wall
- Quilting rulers if you want. I am not a quilting ruler prohibiter. I like my 6.5x24" but a 4x14" works just fine.
- 2 yards each of two contrasting 100% cotton fabric that play together nicely. I suggest solids or prints that read as solids. You can throw in some "pop" colors in small amounts (scraps) if you want.
- spray starch, or Fresh Press or something similar. Stiff improv pieces behave much better!
- marking pens (disappearing type)
- white or off white flannel or batting to cover the design wall and also serves as a vehicle for taking your work home. I just use t-pins to attach the batting and then can remove it easily.
- any other of your favorite quilting tools.
- irons and ironing surfaces if the workroom doesn't have them
