

After the Rain Supply List

Do curves scare you? Well, no worries here – this is a “faux” curved piecing project! What do I mean by that? You’ll see in class! You’ll enjoy this easy take on the traditional Drunkard’s Path block. And we will tackle a partial seam as well! Two in one – how great is that?!

Required Materials:

- After the Rain pattern
 - Available for purchase at www.tamarinis.com
 - Optional kit available for purchase at www.tamarinis.com
- Patience
- A sense of humor

Fabric:

- (1) 10” square stack OR (19) assorted 10” squares from (19) different prints (14 for Crib)
- 1 ¼ yd green fabric (Lap) or 1 yard (Crib)
- 2 ¾ yds cream (background) (Lap) or 1 ¾ yds (Crib)

**please note we will NOT complete the entire project in class.*

Sewing Supplies:

- Sewing Machine (don’t forget your power cord and foot pedal)
- Thread
- Scissors
- Rotary Cutter
- Rotary Mat (18” x 24” or larger)
- Rotary Rulers – long (suggest 6” x 24” or longer) and square (12” x 12” or larger)
- Optional: coordinating thread for top stitching (not required but optional)
- If using heavier thread for embellishing, don’t forget to bring larger needles!
- Template plastic
- Fabric friendly marking tool for tracing template
- Optional but recommended: (4) packages of 9” x 12” Steam A Seam 2 Lite OR 2 yards of Steam a Seam 2 Lite 24” wide

Some General Notes:

- ◆ Yardages listed above are for the Lap Size, but you can do either size. The block size does not change.
- ◆ Please precut your fabrics per page 1 of the pattern (binding and backing are NOT needed for class). Don’t forget to label your cuts for quick reference!
- ◆ Backing and batting listed above are for the table runner only. You will need additional backing and batting for the placemats and mug rugs, should you decide to make those at home. All required materials for all projects are listed on the pattern.

Before session, please:

- Cut all fabrics per the pattern on page one only. Label your cuts by size for quick piecing.
