Required Kit- Nuts and Bolts Quilt Pattern and Blair's Ruby Ruler®- \$25 (this total includes a discount for the Ruby Ruler a

Fabric needed for class- The more t-shirts the better, so plan on bringing a minimum of 15-20 t-shirt panels to work with (see special note below on pre-class prep).

Other Supplies Needed-

Lightweight Iron-on Fusible Interfacing- I use Pellon #906F white sheerweight for my t-shirt quilts. You will need lots of this, I recommend getting a full bolt

Rotary Cutter with a fresh blade/Cutting Mat Preferred acrylic cutting ruler for t-shirt panels into 3 ½" and 4 ½" squares Sewing machine with a fresh needle (I recommend an 80/12 ball point needle) and neutral cotton sewing thread for piecing A design wall Iron/ironing surface Pressing cloth or a scrap of fabric roughly the size of a fat qtr, to protect your ironing surface Straight Pins Fabric scissors Seam Ripper

Pre-Class Prep-

All t-shirts should be washed together prior to class. This ensures they will play nicely together in a quilt. Prior to class, please cut the front and back panels out of your t-shirts prior to class, and plan to only bring those panels to class. No other prep is necessary.
